THE JEFFERIES FAMILY.

JOHN JEFFERIES and WILLIAM JEFFERIES were brothers living with their parents in a good farmhouse at Draycott Folliott, Chiseldon, Wilts, in 1686. Previous to this date there were no registers kept in the parish.

JOHN JEFFERIES (the progenitor of our Branch), born 1686, died 1769, aged 83. Buried at Chiseldon, Wilts.

JAMES LUCKETT JEFFERIES, born at Somers Town, London, in 1816. Married Elizabeth Gyde, September, 1844, at Islington. Lived at Coate, Swindon, Wilts. Died at Bath, December 31, 1896, aged 80. Buried at Locksbrook Cemetery, Bath.

ELIZABETH.—Wife, died at Bath, July 21, 1895, aged 77. Buried at Locksbrook Cemetery, Bath.
